## **Project Review Criteria**

To be eligible for the grant program:

- Project must meet the minimum requirements for the grant program as set out on the program website and HPF manual including: an eligible project applicant, project location, project type, and National Register and/or Virginia Landmarks Register eligibility
- Applicants must be aware of and be prepared to enter into a 10-year Preservation Agreement
- Project must meet or be able to meet the <u>Secretary of the Interior's Standards for the</u> <u>Treatment of Historic Properties</u>
- Projects must be connected to economic development and/or heritage tourism in their region
- Project outcomes must be clear and feasible.

Priority will be given to:

- Projects that have direct evidence of community involvement and/or support
- Projects with a direct and measurable connection to economic development and/or heritage tourism in their region
- Projects that are shovel ready
